

Commercial Participation in the AKCA's Koi Health Advisor Program  
Conditions and Restrictions

The Associated Koi Clubs of America (the "AKCA") recognizes that if Koi professionals [i.e., those who provide goods and services to the Koi hobby, for example but not limited to, veterinarians, pond maintenance personnel, Koi breeders, Koi dealers, dealers who sell Koi products and services and their employees and representatives (hereinafter referred to as "Commercial Participants")] become better educated in good Koi husbandry, they will be better able to serve the Koi hobby and the hobbyists. Therefore and toward that end, Commercial Participants will be allowed to join the AKCA's Koi Health Advisor ("KHA") program (the "Program") with the following conditions and restrictions:

1. In order to be eligible for to participant in the Program, Commercial Participants must obtain a Professional Membership in AKCA. Annual Professional Membership in AKCA starting July 1 each year is \$240. Contact AKCA's CFO for information.
2. Commercial Participants are advised and must acknowledge that none of the Program material will be geared toward the commercial aspects of Koi.
3. Upon successful completion of the Program, Commercial Participants will be issued a certificate of completion, however, they will not be Certified by the Program. This means the Commercial Participants will have gone through the same basic training but will not be Koi Health Advisors ("KHAs") and must agree not to represent themselves as KHAs.
4. In order to qualify for a certificate of completion, Commercial Participants must successfully pass all tests and attend one hands-on laboratory class for the then-current Program class and comply with all other relevant Program conditions that are required of the Program's non-Commercial Participants.
5. Commercial Participants will not have access to the KHA bulletin board on the AKCA web site.
6. Most, if not all, continuing education courses open to the KHA graduates will be open to the Commercial Participants. Fees will apply.
7. Before entering the Program, Commercial Participants will be required to pay a non-refundable enrollment fee of \$100 to the AKCA.
8. Send completed form and fees to AKCA's CFO.
